

# Ellenville/Wawarsing (right there):

Lovely and picturesque, located at the eastern base of the Catskills Mountains and western base of the Shawangunk Ridge. You will find an abundance of out door activities with the Minnewaska State Park nearby. In the village you will also find weekly farmer's markets, along with quaint cafes and boutiques.

## New Paltz (23 Miles):

New Paltz is a historic, outdoorsy town located in the Hudson Valley region. It is best known for the outdoor recreation and world class rock climbing. The Mohonk preserve is the largest private nature reserve in New York. Take a drive from New Paltz down the scenic Shawanguk Ridge Bypass and you will find many cideries, wineries, and distilleries to enjoy. New Paltz is also home to the Historic Huguenot Street, founded in 1894.

# Bethel (35 Miles):

Bethel was the home location of the Woodstock Music and Arts festival in 1969. The Bethel Preforming Arts Center includes the Woodstock Museum and hosts endless live music concerts, farmer's markets, as well as food and craft beverage festivals year-round. Within Bethel you can also find access to numerous lakes, all within a 5 minute drive of each other.

# HIKING TRAILS & WATERFALLS


#### MINNEWASKA STATE PARK

A 22,275 acre preserve in Ulster County. Enjoy hiking, biking, swimming, boating, rock climbing, or just take in the beautiful scenery. The park features numerous waterfalls, three lakes, dense hardwood forests, and beautiful views. There is 35 miles of carriage roads and 50 miles of foot paths. Below are some must see areas within the state park.

Sam's Point- Located on the highest section of the Shawangunk Mountains, and the most southerly section of Minnewaska State Park. Within Sams's Point you can explore trails through the Ice Caves. Lake Maratanza- The highest lake in the Shawangunk Ridge at 2,245 feet above sea level, there is a 3.1 mile loop around the lake to enjoy birdwatching or the scenery.

<u>Verkeerderkill Falls-</u> 187 feet tall, you can take a 3 or 8 mile trail to it within the park.

<u>Awosting Falls</u> Dropping down 60 feet into Peterskill stream, these falls are one of the most popular features within Minnewaska State Park. You can easily take a 1.1 mile out and back trail to view these.

# **MOHONK PRESERVE TRAIL**

A somewhat difficult 7.5- mile hike that is within the 8,000 acres of the Mohonk Preserve. This is the largest private nature preserve in New York.

# **MOHONK MOUNTAIN TRAIL RIDES**

Another way to view and get different scenery in the Mohonk Preserve is with the Mohonk Mountain House. Experience the beauty of the preserve on guided horseback rides, or private group rides.

# **LIPPMAN PARK**

115.3 acre park with 8.5 miles of trails connecting each other to explore. Large pond with fishing access as well!


# ROOST STUDIOS AND ART GALLERY
