

Hannacroix/New Baltimore (right there):

New Baltimore is in the northeast corner of Greene County and overlooks the Hudson River. Less than 20 miles south of Albany, and under two hours north of New York City, the town of New Baltimore is within one of ten counties that make up what is known as the Hudson Valley. The Hudson Valley region is great for those who want their own country retreat away from crowds, and weekends that are more relaxing than hectic!

Coxsackie (8 Miles):

Located along the Hudson River, this is an incredibly welcoming and charmingly preserved town. The name comes from the Algonquin word meaning "Place of Owls" or "Cut Rocks". You will find a beautiful 5 acre riverside park with pristine river front to utilize as well as antiques, a drive-in theater, restaurants, boutiques, and a Farmers Market that runs in the Spring through Fall. The New York Times listed Coxsackie as "A special place on the Hudson".

Albany (18 Miles):

Albany is a 400-year-old city on the banks of the Hudson River. Within a short drive from New Baltimore you will find yourself in New York State's Capital City and all it has to offer. The heart of downtown has a vibrant urban setting and is filled with small businesses, galleries, fine dining, entertainment, museums, and much more.

CORNELL PARK


Located right on the river in New Baltimore, this park offers great views of the Hudson River any time of year.

In the spring, fisherman come in abundance to fish for Striped Bass. In the summer you can watch the boats go by and relax with a BBQ or there is a launch for canoes, or kayaks to get out and explore the river.



113 acre preserve includes several marked hiking trails leading to a lovely waterfall. There are four major trails that have a 4.3 rating with AllTrails Community reviews.

You can also enjoy non motorized activities such as cross country skiing, snowshoeing, bird watching, and leisurely walking.



FOUR MILE POINT PRESERVE

Located in Coxsackie this is a 7 acre preserve with lively wetland, and shoreline picnic destinations. There is an observation deck over looking Vosburgh Swamp that is great for birdwatching. You can hike to an overlook and view the Hudson River from above. Bring a fishing pole, or kayak for more outdoor fun.

<u>HUDSON RIVER SKYWALK</u>

18 miles south of New Baltimore you can visit the Hudson River Skywalk offering breathtaking views of the Hudson River and the Catskill Mountains. The Skywalk is a six mile out and back walkway over the Hudson River connecting two national historic landmarks.




THE EGG

Agency Building 1, S Mall Arterial, Albany, NY 12203


