WATERFALLS & GORGES

TAUGHANNOCK FALLS

Trumansburg, NY

4 miles from Breezy Meadows Farm

One of the most popular waterfalls to visit, with a drop over 215 feet, making it the tallest single-drop waterfall east of the Rocky Mountains.

Experience breath taking views and feel the mist of the falls from two different lookout points

ITHACA FALLS

Ithaca, NY

Ithaca is home to over 150 waterfalls, slightly north of downtown you will find Ithaca Falls. Standing over 100 feet tall and wider than it is tall, this is one of Ithaca's most impressive falls. It has great hiking trails around it which get you very close to the falls. The creek at the base is also a popular spot for fly fishing

WATERFALLS & GORGES

BUTTERMILK FALLS

Ithaca, NY

Buttermilk falls is 165 feet high , tumbling in a wide frothy cascade. The upper park has a small lake, hiking trails through woodland areas along the gorge and rim. There are 9 other waterfalls accessible by hiking the gorge trail

CASCADILLA FALLS

Ithaca, NY

Cascadilla Falls is 20 feet of multiple cascading falls. The stone trails date back to the 1920's. A very popular gorge trail that connects Cornell University to downtown Ithaca

FALL CREEK GORGE

Ithaca, NY

With a depth of nearly 200 feet, Fall Creek Gorge is the largest stream draining into Cayuga Lake. This hike through the gorge provides scenic views, trails, plant and wild life habitat.

FINGER LAKES NATIONAL FOREST



<u>Facts on the Finger</u> <u>Lakes National Forest</u>

FLNF is New York's only public, federally managed national forest.

6 miles west of Breezy Meadows Farm

Wooded glens and open pastures comprise the majority of the landscape in the Finger Lakes National Forest where the wooded areas are similar in character to state forests, managed by the Department of Environmental Conservation. However, the pastures are what make these trails distinct from those in other forests. As is the case on many federally owned lands, grazing is permitted. Hikers will find that they share the pastures with cattle during the months of May to October, and must use a series of locking cattle gates when venturing in and out of the fields. Aside from the oddity of bovine accompaniment, the pastures offer excellent vistas that are especially beautiful in the fall when the hills across Seneca Lake are emblazoned with autumn colors. -Finger Lakes Land Trust




