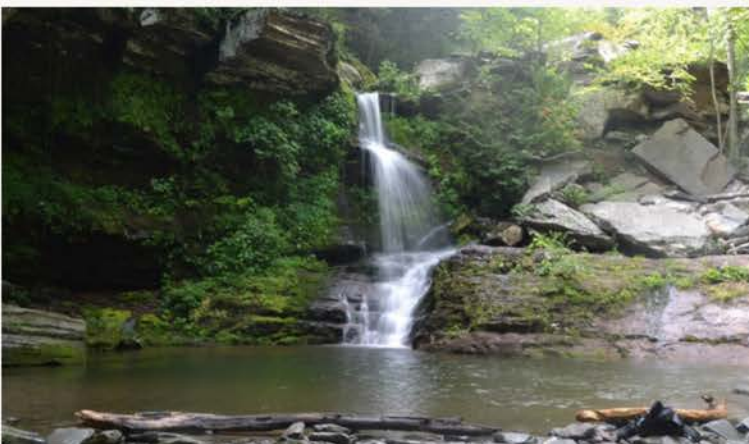


## PLATTEKILL CREEK
